Protocols for Candidates

The protocol for Gold Rush District candidates is to be in the correct scout uniform when attending our advancement Board of Reviews, with proper rank and merit badges that should be worn for their current rank and leadership position. Additionally, the position patches should be correct for their current rank at the time of the board of review, as they are being reviewed for now.

The Scout Troop Advancement Committee and the scoutmaster of each troop should ensure that each scout candidate, before appearing in front of the Gold Rush District board of review, is in proper uniform with the appropriate scout patches and rank for their leadership roles.

When coming for the Eagle Board of Review, the scout should have their Scoutbook with all the correct documentation and signatures and the Scoutbook computer system individual report with the same information recorded in the Scout Book.

The Scout Book and the scout candidates' individual report information need to be examined and reviewed by the Gold Rush District board of review personnel to ensure that all these records correspond with each other so that when the time comes for the Eagle Board verification process. That the scout records are not called into question and are verified without delays in this process.

We look forward to ensuring that all our Gold Rush District scouts coming for the Board of Review are ready for this process and prepared with the correct uniform and paperwork to be seen for their Board Review and in the appropriate uniform for the process. In addition, we want the Scout Candidate to be ready for success in the advancement procedures.

The Gold Rush Board of Review in Cabarrus and Rowan counties looks forward to working with each scout troop in our district to make the advancement process as streamlined and efficient as possible. We can accomplish this task with all scout troop advancement committees, and with all scoutmaster help, we can accomplish this task effectively.
