Roundtables are a form of commissioner service and supplemental training for the volunteers at the unit level. It gives them an example for unit meetings, information on policy, events and training ceremonies, and an opportunity to share experiences and enjoy fun and fellowship so they will be able to provide a stronger program for their Scouting unit.

Functions of the Roundtable

The functions of the roundtable are to:

- provide unit leaders with the will-to-do; the morale, enthusiasm, inspiration, and vision that periodically renews the desire to carry on.
- provide unit leaders with the skill-to-do; the skills, techniques, information, program ideas, and the know-how that makes a unit operation successful.

Who Attends Roundtables?

Roundtables are designed for all unit leaders; their assistants, as well as unit committee members and prospective leaders.

Unit commissioners attend the roundtables in which their leaders are involved. This may mean dividing their time between roundtables for Cub and Scouts BSA leaders.
