This scholarship is intended to assist Eagle Scouts in their pursuit of higher education.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS To be considered for this award, an applicant must:

1. Be a currently registered member of the **Central North Carolina Council, Scouting America**.
2. Have earned the rank of **Eagle Scout** prior to submitting this application.
3. Be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in an accredited college, university, or trade school.
4. Demonstrate leadership in Scouting, school, and the community.
